Alternative submission format (video/audio)

Applicants submitting via video or audio should cover the **same questions as in the form**, in order. Please include the following:

Company Details

1. Full legal name of company
2. Registered address
3. Company number
4. Website
5. Nation/Region
6. Please provide more information about how you meet the criteria for either a ethnically diverse led or a black led indie?
7. Names of key creative leaders
8. Previous credits of key creative leaders

About the IP

9. Title of Intellectual Property (IP)
10. What type of IP are you looking to adapt? (e.g. Book / Novel/ Play / Article / Web series / Podcast / Short film etc.)
11. Tell us more about the IP you're pitching
12. Has the IP previously been adapted?

Rights

13. Who is the rights holder of the IP?
14. Please outline any communication you've had relating to the IP and status to date (please provide details of any discussions, options, agreements, etc.)

Creative Materials and Creators

15. Synopsis of the original work (aim for what you'd write in 400 words)
16. Why you want to adapt the IP? (aim for what you'd write in 200–300 words)
17. What scriptwriter are you looking to work with for the IP Fund?



Please include:

- 1- 2 page pitch
- Sample of the Scriptwriter's work
- Scriptwriter's CV/ Credit

Technical Notes

- Keep video/audio to max 10 minutes.
- Structure responses in the same order as above.
- File types accepted: MP4, MOV, MP3, WAV, M4A.
- Name files as: ProjectTitle_IndieName_Date.
